Their ministry could now begin to put the enemy to flight and take over the world.

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John's Corner

Prayer in Calamity

When we are exposed to events which are so much bigger than our selves, we are quickly brought to a thought of prayer. More recently, we observed the tremendous earthquake in Haiti with a death toll of over 100,000 people.

Most of us watched the horrific aftermath of death and destruction, having global T.V. access. Even the unsaved uttered an "oh God", realizing events of this nature are so far beyond our human abilities. We are confronted with circumstances of devastation where the human mind loses hope in humanity's ability to face the calamity.

On February the 28th, we again saw what could have been much worse, the results of a 8.8 earthquake in Chile where approximately 500 people perished.

This brings me to several thoughts. First, why is it that we need huge devastations in the world or within our personal lives to bring us to prayer. Perhaps the mercy of God allows such calamities whether mega natural events, or the devastations of war to wake up our slumbering spirits to our human need. After all did God not say (Ge. 3:17) "*cursed is the ground for thy sake*"; "**FOR THY SAKE**", Thus explaining His love for us even in judgment and difficulties.

After all, how many seek for God when they have no difficulties to face. This is why our Lord Jesus said (Math. 19:24) "*And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God*". Those who have no need, especially the wealthy are self reliant, and live in the pride realm of self sufficiency. Notice this text was started with the statement of "again I say unto you". This thought is worthy of repetition.

Self reliance puts man on the throne of his life, which is much more of a challenge for the rich. The 8.8 earthquake affecting Chile also caused a tsunami warning to be issued to the entire Pacific basin. Hundreds of thousands fled to higher ground in the Philippines and elsewhere, fearing the potential giant waves.

Perhaps for many of us the death of a loved one, loss of a job, separation within a family or just the loss of a friend has the same affect. We are faced with the devastation of the tsunamis within our soul by life's calamities. Often our instinctive prayers are a cry of our inability to deal with the internal wounding, the circumstances responded to with "**Oh God**". I wonder how many consider the heart of God in viewing these matters. How often does God's heart not cry out with an "**Oh people**", to a people who only look to Him in their calamities? This is not just a figment of imagination.

Did Jesus while sitting on a lonely hillside overlooking the city not cry out with anguish of heart, (Mat 23:37) "*O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathers her chickens under her wings, and ye would not*"! Again, Asaph in (Psa 81:13) under the anointing spoke God's heart; "*Oh that my people had hearkened unto me, and Israel had walked in my ways! 14 I should soon have subdued their enemies, and turned my hand against their adversaries*". Our holy God desires a people whom will walk with Him, talk with Him and commune in continual fellowship of heart. This is why Paul wrote (1Th 5:17) "*Pray without ceasing*". This praying none stop is always much easier for those who have had a genuine experiential "*baptism in the Holy Spirit*", by our Lord Jesus

Christ. A genuine Spirit filled walk and life is achieved by those who desire Him.

Religiosity is a following of religion with a purpose wanting a desired end. A genuine walking after the Spirit (Ro. 8:1-9), is a relationship desire wanting Him and what He is. Why do we need calamities to bring us to prayer? Our holy God desires a people who desire a holy relationship, which will be evidenced by a continual communing with Him, moment by moment 24/7 -365.

When we consider the earthquake and tsunami affects, causing a large number of people to experience a premature death, most of us think "how terrible". May we examine the unholy facts of life. Approximately 16,000 people perish hourly worldwide, with many "many" not knowing Christ. These souls are headed for an everlasting lost eternity. **HOW TERRIBLE IS THAT?**

If we love God we must care for these souls Christ died for. We must see our opportunity to make a difference! We must know the truth of (1Pe 2:9) "*But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light.*" We must know of our potential as a priesthood before Almighty God.

We have the privilege of interceding before His mercy throne for the lost. We have the God given and stated knowledge of (Jas 5:16) "*pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. May this knowledge and realization cause us to pray "fervently"*".

"Holy God and Father in heaven, help us to be a praying people, with enough love to intercede for those around us. **Send a mighty revival** with conviction of sin. May the "*zeal of the Lord*" (Isai. 9:7), be upon us and transform us to be of one heart with you in heaven. **You loved us and gave us our Savior, who died for all humanity. However we know that it is only those who know and believe on the name of Jesus who shall be saved.** Lord Jesus may we make your name and person known and glorious as the Lord of salvation to this lost and dying world. May we witness and not be ashamed of the gospel of our salvation. Grant us hearts filled with love for the lost and religious unknowing. Grant us hearts of compassion for those who do not walk with you. We pray for the nation of Haiti and Chile and the people who suffer due to this catastrophe. We intercede and pray for all of the lost of this world. May your Kingdom come, on earth as it is in heaven. We ask this in the name of the sacrificed lamb of God, Our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen"!□

“I have finished the work which Thou gavest Me to do.”

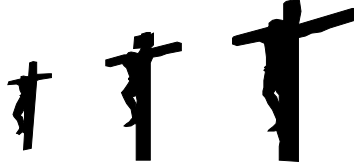
John 17:4

Destroying the Roots of Denial and Betrayal Before They Destroy You!

Before Jesus died on the cross, two men that were very close to him were used to expose the evil that is intent on destroying the people of God. Whether they knew it or not, Judas Iscariot and Peter have lessons to teach us regarding denial and betrayal.

- Peter denied Jesus - Judas betrayed Jesus
- Judas was destroyed by betrayal - Peter escaped by hair’s breadth.
- Jesus chose Peter - Jesus chose Judas.
- He chose them. They did not choose him. (John 15:16) Jesus loved both men dearly (John 3:16; 13:34, Jeremiah 31:3) But both of them were preyed on by two destructive demonic spirits.

How did it happen? How did Peter become susceptible to this spirit that caused him to deny Jesus? How did Judas become susceptible to a spirit that caused him to betray the one who loved him so dearly?

Peter: when you read the scriptures it becomes evident that Simon Peter was Strong - Industrious – Decisive – Vocal – Authentic - Self confident. He possessed many qualities that are the envy of many. A good number of us would aspire to these qualities. But good qualities without the infusion of the Holy Spirit’s power are simply veiled landmines that can explode without notice. They drive people to rely on their own understanding, to rely on their strength, glory in the accomplishments of the past relying on the good experiences of their history.

Peter is a prime example of this: Peter is a man who came to Jesus in a dramatic way. He is the only disciple who is recorded to have confessed his sinfulness to Jesus. Luke 5:8-10.

(a) Peter walked in the revelation of God. (Matthew 16:16-17 God revealed things to him. Flesh and blood did not reveal this to you but my father in heaven

(b) Peter opened himself up to satanic influence. (Matthew 16:21-23 Jesus was rebuking the devil who was certainly speaking through Peter’s mouth)

(c) Relied on his strength. (John 13:36-37 ready to fight; 18:10-11 readily pulled out his sword.

Peter was self reliant and confident - Peter believed that we have the ability to do better - Peter acted passionately. The brother who was so strong, industrious, decisive, confident, a man who demonstrated impeccable ability to walk in the revelation of God ended up denying Jesus. **Why?** How could this be? **Targeted** (Jesus tells that Peter was targeted by the devil Luke 22:31-31 **Self reliant** (the Scriptures show us that Peter relied on himself to accomplish things. In the face of shock, Peter was relying on his strength. So when he got hit, he relented and denied Jesus.

Peter denied Jesus because of perceived failure. Jesus was paraded before the high priest, scourged by the roman soldiers and scorned by the public. He seemed powerless. Peter could not understand this. In the face of perceived failure, when he saw that the only one who could have helped him out was under siege, he denied him.

Like Peter we deny not because we do not care. Not because we are liars. Not because we did not mean what we said. We deny because we

“He Is Already Gone”

“Ja foi!” These are the Portuguese words for *“he is already gone”*. The Brazilian doctor spoke these words to us August 9, 1991. Our seven-year-old son Matthew had battled for 52 hours in the hospital with spinal meningitis. His heart could battle no more. The unthinkable was happening to us”. – Melody Huffman

Matthew Huffman the son of missionaries in Salvador Brazil awoke one morning complaining of a fever. As his temperature soared he began to lose his eyesight. His mother and father put him in the car and raced to the nearest hospital.

As they drove, the boy lay in his mother's lap listless. Then suddenly he put one hand into the air. His mother took it gently and pulled it down to his body. He extended it again. Again she pulled it down. A third time he reached into the air. Confused at his unusual behavior, she asked her son *“Honey what are you reaching for? Just be still”*. He answered, *“I'm reaching for Jesus' hand”*. With those words Matthew closed his eyes and slid into a coma from which he never awakened. He died two days later a victim of bacterial meningitis.

Matthew did not have a long life, but he learned the most important lesson a person can learn before he or she dies; he learned whom to reach for in the hour of death. Matthew's up stretched hand was more eloquent than any prayer he might have made. It said in action what words could never fully convey.

I'm sure we have all heard stories like the one above – stories about Christians when on their death bed reaching towards heaven or calling out to the Lord and in some instances seeing angels beckoning or welcoming them to come home. Now we might say that delirium has set in, but something seems to indicate as to when they are crossing over

into the Spiritual realm.

For example, I know of a wonderful Christian man lying in a coma for days, when all of a sudden he called out, *“Don't you see it? There's the angels. Can't you hear the singing?”* He then slipped into eternity.

Now we don't know where your communion with the Lord is today, but no matter where we may be in our walk, we pray that like the little boy above when trials beset us or when death is knocking on our door, may we too know whom to reach for in our hour of need.

We don't know how long we may have here, but until He calls us home let us continue to labour on in preaching the Gospel. Our Lord said it best before He ascended into Heaven, *“Go ye into all the world and teach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned”*. □

AN INCREDIBLE DAY in the HISTORY OF HAITI -by Jerry Miel (Feb 17).

I think that I will remember this day as one of the most significant in my life, not because of what I did, but for it's meaning... Today was the one month anniversary of the great Haitian earthquake.

About 3 days ago the Haitian President announced that there would be 3 days of holiday from work for the purpose of fasting and prayer. This is absolutely historic. If you have ever been in Haiti as a visitor or missionary, could you ever have imagined such a pronouncement? Could you image such an announcement from the U.S. President? This morning I saw a young Haitian- American woman, the leader of a work team, crying because the Americans could not understand the incredible importance of this day and wanted to go about business as usual. Remember, it was only about 6 years ago that a former Haitian president called the nation to come together to rededicate the nation to Satan.

This was not "a minute of silence for the deceased" or something as equally insignificant. Whatever the President might have originally intended, this became a real commitment for the Haitian people. As I sit here this evening, I can hear the preaching coming from a nearby church. Services have been going on all day...

Let me tell you what I saw and felt today.

Peniel and I had planned an inspection trip up to the Artibonite Valley today. Right or wrong, I don't really know, but since it was the only opportunity, we went ahead with the trip. As we left the guest house about 7:30 am, we were met by throngs of well dressed people headed to various churches. The sounds of Christian music and worship filled the air everywhere. The next observation was that there was NO traffic. Port-au-Prince streets are always clogged and overflowing with bumper to bumper traffic. This morning there were only a few vehicles on the roads, a few small buses (tap taps), some UN and military vehicles, and a few private cars. We had clear sailing through town. The same was true of foot traffic. Usually the streets are clogged also with people walking. Today there were only a few and many of them dressed for church. The only place that there were traffic blocks was in front of several churches where the congregations had overflowed the buildings and the yards and had moved out into the streets as well.

The next observation was that EVERYTHING was closed! We could not find even one business or gas station open. There were no intercity buses running. Whereas the sidewalks are usually overflowing with millions of street vendors, we only saw a few here and there. The huge outdoor market near the wharf where thousands work each day and is spread out to cover most of the street, was EMPTY.

Where were all the people? They were in churches and makeshift meeting sites. Every church (except a JW church) had services going on, almost always overflowing into the streets. Beside broken down churches, services were taking place outside. In homeless camps, there were services. Everywhere the nation was gathered to worship and pray. No, I did not see any voodoo, Islamic, or Buddhist services. This

scene was repeated in every town and hamlet that we passed during the day.

Tonight, Pastor Ignace, who is sharing the room with me, asked this question: "Can people still say that Haiti is a voodoo country?" What has been happening and is continuing to happen in Haiti did not happen because of the earthquake. It has been happening because the Haitian people know how to pray. This is a tremendous outpouring of God's power as the result of prayer. Twenty years ago I started praying for the Gospel to change the Haitian culture. I think that I am seeing God do that work.

The only sadness that I feel today is for our nation. While a nation that has long been under Satan's domination is turning to God with total commitment, our nation, founded on Godly values has rejected God and is rapidly trying to forget that his name even exists.

Let us pray for revival.

“Attack on Canada, U.S. Is Attack On Muslims: Imams”

MONTREAL (CBC) - A group of Canadian and U.S. Islamic leaders on Friday issued a fatwa, or religious edict, declaring that an attack by extremists on the two countries would constitute an attack on the 10 million Muslims living in North America.

The 20 imams associated with the Islamic Supreme Council of Canada said this marked the first fatwa by the Muslim clergy declaring attacks on Canada and the U.S. to be attacks on Muslims. "In our view, these attacks are evil, and Islam requires Muslims to stand up against this evil," the imams said in their fatwa. Calgary Imam Syed Soharwardy, founder of the Islamic Supreme Council of Canada, said attacks on Canadian or U.S. soil are essentially attacks on Muslims. "We are part of this society," he said. "This is my home, and if anybody attacks Canada, in fact, attacks on my home."

The imams said it is a duty of every Muslim in Canada and the U.S. to safeguard the two countries. "They must expose any person, Muslim or non-Muslim, who would cause harm to fellow Canadians or Americans," they said. "It is religious obligation upon Muslims, based upon the Qur'anic teachings, that we have to be loyal to the country where we live," said Soharwardy. "We have no problems in Canada; we can practise our religion freely."

In Montreal, one of the signatories of the edict, Imam Nasir Qadri of the Anwar Musallah Mosque, said he spoke to his followers at his mosque about the issue Friday. Most of them call Canada home and feel personally threatened by the attempted attacks, he said. The 20 imams who signed the fatwa come from British Columbia, Alberta, Ontario, Quebec and Houston. The fatwa comes just weeks after an attempted bombing on Christmas Day of a U.S. jet bound for Detroit from Amsterdam. Umar Farouk Abdulmutallab, a 23-year-old Nigerian man, has been indicted on six charges, which include attempted use of a weapon of mass destruction and attempted murder. □

Was there something that Jacob wanted to become in his own heart, a great man? What a humbling experience this was. He was forever changed. He became a patriarch, carrying the name of God like his forefathers, Abraham and Isaac.

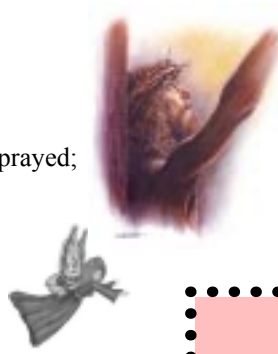
