

Christian Prayer-Meetings at City Hall, Are appropriately conducted In the Chamber.

“Prayer Canada” has conducted Christian Prayer-Meetings, appropriately, at the Delegation-Table, in the Municipal Chamber of the City-Hall of Burnaby. Recently, a Policy had been established, to have such Prayer-Meetings classified as Public Meetings; for which the Municipal Chamber can rightfully not be made available. However, such Classification is inappropriate. Namely, Christian Prayer-Meetings are not a “Public Meeting,” because they do not manifest secular Characteristics or Function.

Christian Prayer-Meetings are always conducted in Compliance with; and under Protection of, the Legal Maxim: “**Dei Gracia Regina**,” “Queen, by the Grace of God,” as imprinted on the Coins issued and circulated in Canada. This Legal Maxim declared Canada, as a “Nation under God,” for which Reason Christians Prayer-Meetings, conducted at the Delegation-Table, in the Chamber of City-Hall, are Part of appropriate Canadian Administration.

An administrative Gesture, such as a By-Law or Policy, intending to have Christian Prayer-Meetings removed from the Chamber; and gradually eliminated from City-Hall, contradicts the above indicated Legal Maxim.

Christian Prayer-Meetings conducted at the Delegation-Table of the Municipal Chamber at City-Hall, are further protected by a Legal Maxim relating to Public Policy: “**Summa Ratio est quæ pro Religione facit**.”

Concerning Legislation of Law, it means: “That Rule is best, which promotes Religion.”

Concerning Administration of Law, it means: “If ever the Laws of God of and Man are at Variance, then the Former are to be obeyed, in Derogation of the Latter.”

Concerning Enforcement of Law, it means: “No Person shall be deemed an Offender, by Reason only, that he contravenes a Law which is not to be obeyed.”

Thus, a By-Law or Policy, to have Christian Prayer-Meetings gradually eliminated from City-Hall, does not only contradict the above two Legal Maxims, but is provably enacted in Compliance with the Manifesto of the Communist Party, which declares Abolition of all Religion; and thereby constitutes “Fabricated Evidence,” according to Criminal Code Sections 137 and 118; and is thereby Subject to Repealment, under Point of Order.

A third Legal Maxim relates to general Administration of Law: “**Lex naturalis**,” “Law is natural.”

The legislative Process follows a “natural” Trend. Namely, what the Public needs, ought to be, or may be, legislated into Law. What the Public does not need; or what the Public would rightfully reject, it properly informed beforehand, can not be legislated into Law; because such a Law would not be “natural;” and could therefore not be provided with Legal Tenure.

Thus, a By-Law or Policy, requesting Christian Prayer-Meetings to be removed from the Council-Chamber; to be gradually eliminated from City-Hall, does not express the Needs of the Public; and in Fact, contradicts it, because supportive Prayer is a vital Part of the Christian Religion and Christian Society.

In This, it needs to be considered, that the Population of Canada presents a Christian Majority of about 90%; for which Reason, the City Council of Burnaby would be well disposed, through the Application of the Principles of Democracy, in appreciating the Presence of appropriately placed Christian Prayer-Meetings, functioning on their Behalf.

It is also appropriate, for the Participants in Christian Prayer-Meetings, to invite such City Councilors, who might have suggested and/or participated in the Establishment of said Policy; in Order to have them effectively restored unto God and unto the City Council.

Namely, according to Law, they have forfeited their administrative Privilege, through the inappropriate Establishment of said Policy, contradicting applicable Legal Maxims; which constitutes Failure to render administrative Service, as required by Law.

Christian Prayer-Meetings, conducted at the Delegation-Table in the Municipal Chamber,
constitute the legal Seal, of the City Councilor’s administrative Privilege.
