Warnings of problems and disaster's of every kind have been flowing through our emails and letters for years. In the last six months they have been much more intense and urgent. Almost everyday we kind of expect to hear of more tornadoes, oil spills, floods, hail, and drought and now ash from a volcano interrupts thousands of air flights, earthquakes and tornadoes have brought devastations and death to thousands.

All of these have been witnessed before to some extent but the severity, size and volume have greatly increased. As we continually pray for protection and direction, I sometimes wonder why the situation worsens. Then I'm immediately reminded of the terrible things we humans allow to happen. We allow our governments to continue to kill your babies **Lord** at an ever increasing rate. In the average month, 2008 – 2009, some 1100 live babies were murdered every month in BC alone, that's just the ones the government records! I cringe as I realize over 100,000 babies are massacred every year in Canada. Psalm 139:13-14 “You Lord have made all the delicate inner parts of my body and knit them together in my mother's womb. I have to tell you Arne, that I've been having some terrific success with my letter writing to various members of parliament on a variety of subjects.

I have felt that the Lord has been giving me things to say, and I've been getting letters back from senior people. Today, I received a letter from Peter McKay where he said that he took the liberty of passing my interesting ideas along to Lawrence Cannon.

I give the Lord the credit for the ideas, as I've been lead to do certain areas of research for a number of years and the Lord is now making use of what has been distilled.

I couple of weeks ago I had a 45-min conversation with a decision maker with World Vision and she asked me to write everything we'd talked about down in a letter. She said she would send my research about the nutritional value and farming techniques of Duckweed to the nutritionist who develops food plans for the world. She also said that she would discuss my other strategies related to disaster response, water resource development, sanitation, and a rainwater collection method with her leaders who develop programs at a world level.

I also received a letter back from our MLA who personally wrote another minister to pilot my letter to him, and asked that the minister answer him directly before responding to me. The matter was regarding: the quality of native services to children in care; cost saving ideas in the foster care system; and present legislation, that has enshrined in law, a shift of responsibility from the natives to the larger society for the impartation of native culture to native children in care etc. I thought you would enjoy hearing something of these special victories.

Boyle, Alberta



The power of prayer

Someone has said if Christians really understood the full extent of the power we have available through prayer, we might be speechless. Did you know that during WWII there was an advisor to Churchill who organized a group of people who dropped what they were doing every day at a prescribed hour for one minute to collectively pray for the safety of England, its people and peace?

There is now a group of people organizing the same thing here in America. If you would like to participate:

Every evening at 9:00 PM Eastern Time (8:00 PM Central) (7:00 PM Mountain) **(6:00 PM Pacific)**, stop whatever you are doing and spend one minute praying for the safety of the United States, our troops, our citizens, and for a return to a Godly nation. If you know anyone else who would like to participate, please pass this along. Our prayers are the most powerful assets we have. Canada can join in for Canada and it’s needs!

LAUS DEO Do you Know What it Means?

One detail that is never mentioned is that in Washington, D.C. there can never be a building of greater height than the Washington Monument. With all the uproar about removing the Ten Commandments, etc., this is worth a moment or two of your time. I was not aware of this amazing historical information.

On the aluminum cap, atop the Washington Monument in Washington, D.C., are displayed two words: Laus Deo. No one can see these words. In fact, most visitors to the monument are totally unaware they are even there and for that matter, probably couldn’t care less.

These words have been there for many years; they are 555 feet, 5.125 inches high, perched atop the monument, facing skyward to the Father of our nation, overlooking the 69 square miles which comprise the District of Columbia, capital of the United States of America.

Laus Deo! Two seemingly insignificant, unnoticed words. Out of sight and, one might think, out of mind, but very meaningfully placed at the highest point over what is the most powerful city in the most successful nation in the world.

So, what do those two words, in Latin, composed of just four syllables and only seven letters, possibly mean? Very simply, they say - Praise be to God!

Though construction of this giant obelisk began in 1848, when James Polk was President of the United States, it was not until 1888 that the monument was inaugurated and opened to the public. It took twenty-five years to finally cap the memorial with a tribute to the Father of our nation, Laus Deo ‘Praise be to God!’

From atop this magnificent granite and marble structure, visitors may take in the beautiful panoramic view of the city with its division into four major segments. From that vantage point, one can also easily see the original plan of the designer, Pierre Charles l’Enfant ... a perfect cross imposed upon the landscape, with the White House to the north. The Jefferson Memorial is to the south, the Capitol to the east and the Lincoln Memorial to the west.

A cross you ask? Why a cross? What about separation of church and state? Yes, a cross; separation of church and state was not, is not, in the Constitution. How interesting and, no doubt, intended to carry a profound meaning for those who bother to notice.

Praise be to God! Within the monument itself are 898 steps and 50 landings. As one climbs the steps and pauses at the landings the memorial stones share a message.

On the 12th Landing is a prayer offered by the City of Baltimore; On the 20th is a memorial presented by some Chinese Christians; On the 24th a presentation made by Sunday School children from New York and Philadelphia quoting Proverbs 10:7, Luke 18:16 and Proverbs 22:6 Praise be to God!

When the cornerstone of the Washington Monument was laid on July 4th, 1848 deposited within it were many items including the Holy Bible, presented by the Bible Society. Praise be to God! Such was the discipline, the moral direction, and the spiritual mood given by the founder and first President of our unique democracy ‘One Nation, Under God.’

I am awed by Washington ‘s prayer for America. /’ Almighty God; we make our earnest prayer that Thou wilt keep the United States in Thy holy protection; that Thou wilt incline the hearts of the citizens to cultivate a spirit of subordination and obedience to government; and entertain a brotherly affection and love for one another and for their fellow citizens of the United States at large. And finally that Thou wilt most graciously be pleased to dispose us all to do justice, to love mercy, and to demean ourselves with that charity, humility, and pacific temper of mind which were the characteristics of the Divine Author of our

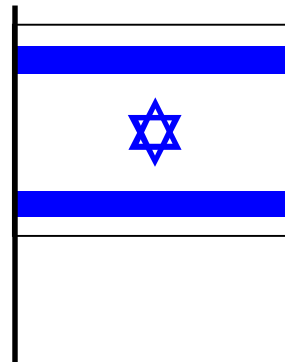

Once the meeting begins you are present to see how the meeting progresses. As the meetings are open to the public there is no permission needed to attend.

Even if the individuals can only stay for the first hour of the council meeting, they have made a vital commitment to not only pray for their city authorities, but also get first hand knowledge of how their mayor and council members operate. Much information is gained by how they treat people and handle the business of the city.

Algeria Church Attacked

Algerian Christians have requested our prayers following a series of incidents at a newly opened church building in the city of Tizi Ouzo, western Algeria.

In November a growing church in the city opened a new church building to replace their previous rented premises. The new building seats 350 worshippers. Shortly afterwards, the authorities issued a letter to the church stating that it was not officially licensed for religious purposes. The church leaders had received similar notices previously but, as in the past, they chose to continue their activities because the church is a member of the Église Protestante d'Algerie which is registered with the authorities.

On 26th December a mob of about 20 gathered at the entrance to the building and tried to prevent worshippers from gathering for their regular Saturday meeting. The church leaders called the police, who attended but did not intervene. Threats were made but no violent acts occurred.

On 27th December Christians returned to the building and again found some of the mob present. Church members were able to speak with them and offered copies of the New Testament.

On 28th December the church building was broken into. This was discovered the next day and the police were informed.

On 2nd January a more serious incident occurred. A mob came to the service threatening worshippers, and manhandled the pastor. The service was stopped and calm was restored. Later in the day a group broke into the building and vandalised the interior until the police arrived and restored order. During the night there was another break-in and many contents were destroyed by a fire, though the structure of the building was not damaged.

Algerian Christians request our prayers that:

- The Lord will keep His peace, patience and protection over the church
- The pastor and all church members will know the wisdom and guidance of the Spirit in all aspects of their lives and witness
- All Christians in Algeria will be able to meet with fellow believers for worship, teaching, fellowship and prayer
- The perpetrators would be convicted by the Spirit, and respond to the truth of Jesus
- The authorities would act decisively to prevent any further attacks□

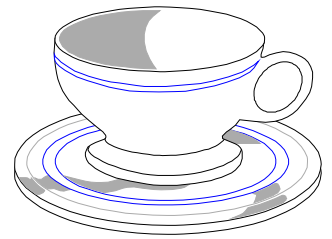
Have you heard about the father and his son who took a donkey to the market? The man sat on the beast and the boy walked.

Insurgents increase attacks on schools Girls’ schools are targeted in order to send a ‘symbolic’ message to foreigners, report finds

Despite the security concerns in schools, student enrolment in Afghanistan has grown over the past few years, from hundreds of thousands to millions. The number of attacks on Afghanistan’s schools — especially girls’ schools — is on the rise, a report released Monday shows. Between January 2006 and December 2008, there were 1153 attacks on Afghanistan schools, including poisonings, murders, rocket attacks and grenades. In 2008 alone, there were 670 attacks — more than the two previous years combined. According to the Afghan Ministry of Education, 230 people died as a result of attacks between 2006 and 2007. At the beginning of 2009, 670 schools from across the country were shut down, with 65 to 81 per cent of schools in the southern provinces closed because of security concerns. Despite the fact that girls make up 19 per cent of Afghan schools, they continue to be targeted, with girls’ schools making up 40 per cent of all schools attacked, says the report, released by non-governmental organization CARE International, in conjunction with the government of Afghanistan and the World Bank.

It is the first study to take a comprehensive look at school attacks and to offer suggestions about how to better the education system in Afghanistan. Over 1000 community members, educators and students were interviewed for the report. “Everyone knows that education is key to success in Afghanistan, and it is critical for the country. But no one wants to be building schools to see them burn down or blown up,” said Kevin McCort, the President and CEO of CARE Canada. McCort said girls’ schools are often attacked as a “symbolic” gesture by insurgents who want to send the military or foreign governments a message. Criminal groups, tribal infighting, and individuals from the community have also contributed to attacks. To quell the violence, countries like Canada should avoid publicizing their contributions, said McCort. “The kind of stuff that works in Canada — a big photo-op in front of a school and everybody’s happy — that actually increases the risk to that school,” he said. Afghans “want to be under the radar. They want to be anonymous, because anonymity is protection.” □

Along the Indian Road

Karnataka state recorded the highest number of anti-Christian attacks in India last year, and it is keeping pace this year. They are being attacked “at rapid regularity” and “with near impunity,” and it is “a serious matter of concern for the Christian community,” said Dr. Babu Joseph, spokesperson of the Catholic Bishops’ Conference of India (CBCI).

Much of the violence occurs under the vigilante pretext of rounding up Christians supposedly involved in “forcible” or “fraudulent” conversion efforts. On Monday (Feb. 1) in Thagadur village, Kodagu district, Hindu extremists dragged 11 Christians – including four women – from their homes and colluded with police to arrest them on such false

charges.

The Global Council of Indian Christians reported that all of the Christians, members of the Beraka Gospel Church in Suntikupa village, were tortured at the Siddapur police station to pressure them to admit to the charges. Most of the jailed Christians are tribal, daily wage laborers who work on coffee plantations.

Police denied torturing the Christians, but like many people in India easily confused by Hindu extremist propaganda, Inspector Ratan Singh of the Siddapur police station seemed to erroneously believe that laws against fraudulent conversion apply to any kind of proclamation of faith.

Martyred: 176,000 Christians in One Year

A new ministry partnership has launched a campaign to raise awareness of the fact an estimated 176,000 Christians were martyred, killed for their faith, in a one-year period from the middle of 2008 to the middle of 2009.

Martyrdom didn't go away with the Middle Ages, according to reports from Open Doors USA, which now has combined efforts with actor Kirk Cameron of "The Way of the Master" ministry as well as evangelist Ray Comfort of Living Waters ministry to focus on those who are being persecuted for their faith. The report cited North Korea, which reportedly uses Christians as guinea pigs to test chemical and biological weapons, as the world's worst persecutor of Christians.

Open Doors estimates there are 100 million Christians worldwide who suffer interrogation, arrest and even death for their faith, with millions more facing discrimination and alienation. □

"Canada"

A two-day meeting of G8 development ministers got underway in Halifax with a debate on abortion looming over a discussion on improving maternal and child health in poor countries.

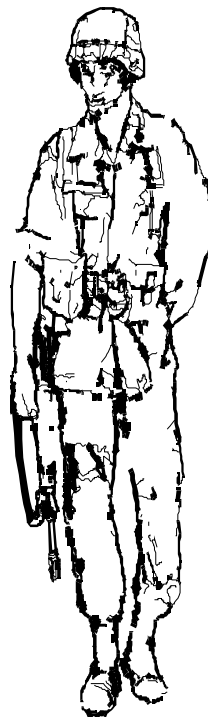
Canada announced it won't support funding for abortions in the developing world as part of a family planning initiative it is pushing as a key agenda item for a meeting of G8 leaders in June in Huntsville, Ontario.

As well, Ms Oda said, she recently met with other development ministers in Washington and New York where she was told there was no disagreement with Canada's position.

"They all support Canada's initiative" she said. "There is no division on what it includes."

At the opening of the meeting in Halifax, Ms. Oda said as host of this year's G8 meeting Canada is in a position to help women and children in developing countries by improving their health and reducing preventable diseases.

"Canada recognizes that we are in a position, along with other G8 countries, to take action to help millions who today are still facing an uncertain future, continued hunger, early deaths and little or no access to the basic needs of life, and particularly women", she said. World Vision Canada says there are 8.8 million child deaths a year from preventable conditions like diarrhea, malaria and pneumonia. □

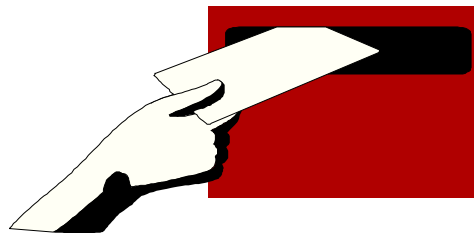
